

Minutes from January 10, 2022  
Cherokee Charter Academy Board Meeting

Present – Michelle Clark, Sue Turner, Carlton Bridges, AK Parker by phone, and Suzanne Turner by ZOOM. Chair Clark called the meeting to order welcoming all at 5:04 pm and asked Sue Turner to read the Mission Statement and Roger Miller to lead in opening prayer.

Chair Clark opened the floor to public comment. Melody McNeely, an assistant in 6<sup>th</sup> grade spoke on her view of issues with the same students and discipline, some staff that arrive late and leave early, no supply closet for teachers, and to hold students accountable for their lack of attendance. Travis Horton, 4<sup>th</sup> grade teacher spoke on the delay in getting Beta Cups and Archery items that parents gave funds for or fund raised to purchase. The Board assured Mr. Horton that the funds were in the account and the purchases would be made.
